



Co-design a Human Rights Support Solution with BIHR

Explaining our income limit

BIHR's Community Programme 2022-2025 is aimed at providing Human Rights Act support for organisations with a current annual income of £750,000 or under. On our application form, we ask you to confirm your community or voluntary group meets this criteria and to provide a link to your most recent annual accounts.

We recognise that some local groups may be delivering local statutory services or commissioned work, such as advocacy, support, or refuge, and this can tip the organisation's annual income over BIHR's limit. If this applies to your organisation, provided you are a voluntary or community organisation operating independently (with your own accounts), we will ask you to confirm that your unrestricted income is less than £750,000 a year. Teams, groupings and networks that are not independent organisations in their own right, and which are part of another organisation with an income of over £750,000 a year are not eligible for this programme.

As a small charity ourselves (BIHR's income is less than £450,000 a year), we are prioritising fundraising that enables us to provide this support for free so far as possible. We know that our criteria means that some organisations will unfortunately not be eligible for this programme.
