   	<p>The aim of the human rights programme is to create something that will help your group.</p>
 	<p>We will work with you to make a human rights solution that works best for you.</p>

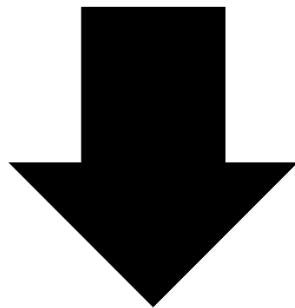
	<p>The programme will take place from May 2024 to July 2028.</p>
	<p>Successful groups will be offered £5000 in May 2024 to start the work.</p>
	<p>Successful groups will then be offered £50,000 every year for 4 years.</p>
<p>3. Who can apply</p>	



You should only apply if your group meets all of the criteria below.



Your group must be based in London.



**£750,000**

Your group must have an annual income of less than £750,000.



Your group must work closely with people in your



community and be able to involve them.



Your group must be able to work with us for 4 years.



Your group must be able to show that you have worked on programmes like this one before.





Your group must work on human rights issues such as health, housing, poverty or disability rights.



If your group meets the above criteria, read below to find out how to apply.



If any of the above does not apply to your group, please do not apply. Your application will not be considered.

We will ask you if you would like to apply using our form or by video.





We will then send you the application form and/or video instructions.

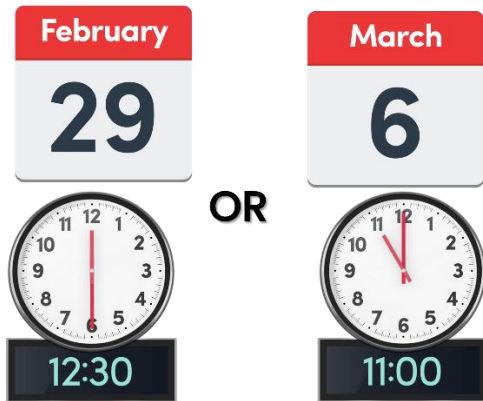


You must return your application form or application video to us by Monday 25th March 2024 at 5pm.

These meetings will take place online on Zoom on **29th February 12:30pm – 1:30pm**, and **6th March 5 – 6pm**.

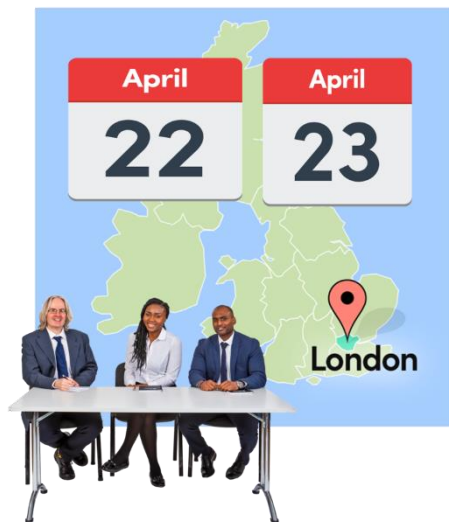
